## NATIONAL QUALIFICATION IN EVENT STEWARDING

### The Edexcel L2 NVQ in Spectator Safety

This course has been specially designed for those working at public events where crowd control and safety is important. It involves a number of classroom sessions, 2 or 3 “assessments” in your stewarding role (when an assessor will come and observe you doing your job) and a small amount of home study. Depending on how quickly *you* want to achieve, the course can take as little as 14 weeks.

The Award is recognised by Licensing Authorities across the country and is a mandatory requirement for premier football grounds and stadiums. It will be a valuable qualification to hold for those that may be interested in stewarding at the 2012 Olympic Games, or indeed at any other major music, sporting or festival event.

### What will you learn?

The course is divided into SIX units and all of them must be completed.

1. Prepare for spectator events
2. Control the entry, exit and movement of people at spectator events
3. Monitor spectators and deal with crowd problems
4. Help to manage conflict
5. Contribute to the work of your team
6. Deal with accidents and emergencies

### Entry requirements

Learners must be 16 years of age or above, and have lived in the EU for the last three years. It is also a requirement to commit to ‘steward’ on a voluntary basis at a average of 4 SLS events over the coming season.

### Where, When and how much?

Initial training for the next course will be held in Barnstaple in June 2010. The course will be at no cost to those eligible for funding, or £700 plus vat for those that are not eligible.
